

**Castlewood City Council  
November 13, 2017**

The Castlewood City Council met in special session on the above date at 6:30 p.m. with the following members present: Mayor Paul Friske, Brian Ries, Heather Schmit, Jeff Shepherd, Jeff Dahl, Shawn Mullaney and Ryman Dockter. Also present: Sheila Gerhold and Rick Ries.

The meeting was called to order by the mayor.

The agenda was approved on a motion by Mullaney and seconded by Ries with all members present in favor and motion passed.

The plat for Railroad Warehouse Second Addition was presented for approval. The following resolution was approved on a motion by Mullaney and seconded by Ries with all members in favor and motion passed:

**RESOLUTION #05-17**

Be it resolved by the City Council, Castlewood, South Dakota having viewed this plat and having received a recommendation from the Castlewood City Plan Commission, does hereby approve this plat of "Railroad Warehouse Second Addition to the City of Castlewood in the County of Hamlin, South Dakota. The Castlewood Fire Department requested permission to burn the Roger Goens property down. Dockter made a motion to approve if the fireman follow all safety precautions with a second by Dahl with all members in favor and motion passed.

Discussion was held on the city's sewer pumps. A new pump is \$8,903 and a rebuilt pump is \$6,240. The city would have two pumps to get rebuilt. A motion by Mullaney and seconded by Dockter to rebuild the two pumps. All in favor and motion passed.

A bill for insurance repairs from the Gerhold Brothers was presented in the amount of \$969 for labor to repair dugouts, maintenance shed and cart shed at the golf course. A motion by Ries and seconded by Schmit to approve the bill. All in favor and motion passed.

A motion by Mullaney and seconded by Dockter to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
